He is currently member of the Board of Directors of, ICASO, as well of Mpact Global Action Board (formerly Global Forum of Men Who Have Sex with Men and HIV), he is the Coordinator of GayLatino Mexico and member of GayLatino's Board. Since 2017 he is part of the Community Delegation of the Governing Board of the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria. He is founder and Training Commissioner of the LGBTTTI + Mexican Coalition. He works as an independent consultant for APMG Health, for GATE Global Action for Transgender Equality, and for Symposia.

He is speaker and author of numerous publications about HIV, Social Contracting, Sexual Health and Sexual rights, Sexual Diversity and Human Rights, support for Trans persons and their families, Advocacy training for communities.

Nowadays he is a consultant for The Latin America and the Caribbean Regional Platform for support, coordination and communication of Civil Society and Communities (LAC Platform), an initiative driven by VIA LIBRE and supported by the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria.
