Dr Carlos Rodriguez-Diaz is a community health educator by training and a socio-behavioural scientist with experience in health promotion, health policy, human rights and health diplomacy. Dr Rodriguez-Diaz has been working in the HIV and sexual health promotion field in Puerto Rico, the US and the Caribbean for more than 15 years. He has collaborated in advocacy and research initiatives with governmental and non-governmental organizations. Most of his work in the public health field has been dedicated to developing socio-behavioural interventions and research to address the needs of populations otherwise made socially vulnerable, including people with HIV, transgender men and women, and gay, bisexual and other men who have sex with other men. Currently, Dr Rodriguez-Diaz is Associate Professor at Milken Institute School of Public Health at The George Washington University and Adjunct Professor at the School of Public Health of the University of Puerto Rico-Medical Sciences Campus.
