She was a member of the Global Review Panel of the UNAIDS Operating Model in 2017, and served on the UN/Lancet Global Commission on the future of health in sub-

Saharan Africa. Dr Kilonzo holds a PhD in tropical medicine from the Liverpool School of Tropical Medicine. Her professional experience spans the government, the UN and private sectors, with more than 20 years in public health and development. She has led policy and formulation and implementation of innovative public health programmes in HIV and gender-based violence prevention and control programmes in Kenya, Malawi, Botswana and Cote d'Ivoire. Dr Kilonzo has more than 30 peer-reviewed publications in high-impact factor journals, commissioned reports and book chapters in the areas of HIV prevention and control in Africa.
