Sarah Palmer is the Deputy Director of the Centre for Virus Research at the Westmead Institute for Medical Research and Associate Professor in the Faculty of Medicine and Health at the University of Sydney School of Medicine, Sydney, Australia. Her principal areas of research interest focus on molecular and medical virology and the application of innovative techniques and assays that provide new insights into disease pathogenesis and treatment, especially for HIV. Her current work focuses on understanding the genetic characteristics and dynamics of persistent HIV across a range of tissues and cells to guide and assess treatment interventions designed to reduce persistent HIV reservoirs and inform HIV eradication strategies. Dr Palmer has a PhD in medical sciences (virology) from the Karolinska Institutet, Stockholm, Sweden. She conducted her postdoctoral studies at the Center for AIDS Research,

Stanford University Medical School, Stanford, US.
