Jorge Sanchez is a specialist in infectious and tropical diseases. He studied at the Universidad Peruana Cayetano Heredia, Peru, and has a Master of Public Health in epidemiology from the University of Washington, US. Since 1986, he has worked extensively in HIV/STI and TB epidemiology, clinical research and implementation science. He is currently Affiliate Professor of the Department of Global Health at the University of Washington. From 1995 to 2000, he was advisor to the Minister of Health and Director of the Peruvian HIV control programme. In 2000, he became the principal investigator of an HIV clinical research site and, since 2006, of the HIV Clinical Trial Unit (CTU) in Peru. The CTU is pluripotent and multidimensional, and currently serves four Division of Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome clinical research networks (HVTN, HPTN, MTN, ACTG) through four clinical research sites. Sanchez is at the Centro de Investigaciones Tecnológicas, Biomédicas y Medioambientales at Universidad Nacional Mayor de San Marcos.
